Image caption Social networking has replaced the bar as the most popular way to meet friends and make new friends Young people in Scotland are more likely to use social networking sites than their UK counterparts, a survey suggests. People under 35 in Scotland are more likely to use social networking sites than their UK counterparts, it found. The study for the Body Shop and British Heart Foundation has shown a 10% rise in people using social networks between 2005 and 2009. The charity said social networks could prove to be an important tool in stopping the number of heart disease and stroke cases. The study found that 51% of 18-35 year olds in Scotland had social networking sites in their household compared to 39% in the UK. Scottish teenagers are also more likely to use e-mail, video phones, and the internet to communicate than their UK counterparts, with 82% of Scottish teenagers using e-mail, compared to 79% of UK teenagers. And while just over half of teenagers in Scotland (53%) have a mobile phone compared to 68% in the UK, 11% of Scots have internet access at home compared to 19% of UK teenagers. Survey The Body Shop's survey on Body and Soul 2006 - 2009, for which 2,000 people in Scotland were interviewed, found that 16-25-year-olds in Scotland were twice as likely to use social networking sites as their UK counterparts, and were twice as likely to use video phone services. The charity and the British Heart Foundation said the growing popularity of social networking sites, such as Facebook, could be an important tool in the fight against heart disease and stroke. The two charities said online social networking could help in the prevention of heart disease and stroke

The new Markup Assist tool enables you to incorporate feedback from customer drawings or from a technician's work ticket into your drawings. Customer feedback is often expressed via hand-drawn marks or printed marks. This marks import tool enables you to automatically incorporate the marks from a customer drawing or technician's ticket into your drawings. Many designers incorporate drawings with customer comments and technical details into their drawings. We are including hand-drawn marks in AutoCAD 2023 so that you can incorporate those marks into your drawings for design reviews. This is useful to keep the comments up to date. Under the new Cross-Reference System (XRS), when you create a 2D sketch from a 3D drawing, you will get a warning if the piece's X, Y, and Z coordinates are not correctly set. For more information, see the AutoCAD cross-reference system in the new release notes. Flood Light: You can now create an AutoLISP function that enables you to invoke the flood light on your drawing surface. You can then customize the flood light effect for any drawing object on the drawing surface. See the video below for details.
